

**REGULAR BOARD MEETING  
VILLAGE OF TEUTOPOLIS  
AUGUST 17, 2011**

The regular meeting of the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Teutopolis, Effingham County, State of Illinois, was held in the Village Hall of said Village on August 17, 2011 at 7:00 p.m.

The President called the meeting to order and upon roll call the following trustees were present:

A hearing was held to review the delinquent water bills. None of the persons having a delinquent bill were present at the hearing. Since no one was present to give just cause for being late the Village Foreman was instructed to disconnect their water on the 18<sup>th</sup>.

It was moved by Greg Oseland, seconded by David Tegeler and carried to amend the August 03, 2011 minutes to read: Charles Runde, representing Runde Clinic, informed the board they are considering expanding the office for an additional doctor as well as more parking to maintain future growth. He stated they are purchasing adjacent property, will need the property rezoned and as part of the expansion the Clinic will need to reroute storm water drainage to Pearl Street and advised the board that enlarging the existing storm sewer may be required and are requesting assistance from the village. The board gave a verbal commitment to work with the clinic to upgrade the storm sewer along Pearl Street if needed. The minutes were then approved as read.

It was moved by Greg Oseland, seconded by Greg Hess and carried that the treasurer's report be accepted and placed on file.

It was moved by John Mette, seconded by Greg Oseland and carried that the board report be approved and the August bills paid.

Board members approved and placed on file the 2010 Motor Fuel Tax Audit Report.


