

**REGULAR BOARD MEETING
VILLAGE OF TEUTOPOLIS
JUNE 15, 2011**

The regular meeting of the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Teutopolis, Effingham County, State of Illinois, was held in the Village Hall of said Village on June 15, 2011 at 7:00 p.m.

The President called the meeting to order and upon roll call the following trustees were present:

A hearing was held by the board to review the delinquent water bills. None of the persons having a delinquent bill were present at the hearing. Since no one was present to give just cause for being late the Village Foreman was instructed to disconnect their water on the 16th.

It was moved by Kenneth Esker, seconded by Greg Hess and carried that the minutes of the last meeting be approved as read.

It was moved by David Tegeler, seconded by John Mette and carried that the treasurer's report be accepted and placed on file.

It was moved by John Mette, seconded by Greg Hess and carried that the board report be approved and the June bills paid.

Motion was made by John Mette, seconded by Greg Hess to pay estimate #4 and final to GRR Construction for \$67,358.03 for the Green Street Water main replacement project. By roll call vote – 5 yes, 0 nays, 1 absent, motion carried.


Motion was made by John Mette, seconded by Kenneth Esker to transfer \$60,000 from the General fund to the Water for payment of the Green Street project. By roll call vote – 5 yes, 0 nays, 1 absent, motion carried.

Motion was made by John Mette, seconded by Greg Hess to transfer \$20,000 from the General Fund to the Building Fund. By roll call vote – 5 yes, 0 nays, 1 absent, motion carried.


After learning the Village had received complaints about being able to see when pulling out of a driveway at 112 West Main the board agreed to paint the curbing in front of 110 West Main yellow and make it a no parking area.

In other action, the board listened to a website presentation by Shelise Parsley, agreed to July 15th as the deadline for sidewalks to be completed at 413 South Oak, approved installing street lights along West Water from the Junior High to Crystal Road, decided not to participate in the tax interruption coverage offered through The Illinois Municipal League and tabled appropriations and maintenance building repairs for two weeks.

It was moved by John Mette, seconded by Greg Hess and carried to adjourn the meeting.
